V.6 Guidelines on MPF Exempted ORSO Schemes – Application for Approval of Appointment of Trustees

INTRODUCTION

Section 7(1) of Schedule 3 to the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes (Exemption) Regulation (the Exemption Regulation) provides that a person who has the duty or power to retire or appoint the trustee of a scheme shall obtain the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority's (the Authority's) approval in writing before retiring or appointing the trustee.

- 2. With regard to the appointment of a trustee, section 7(3) of Schedule 3 to the Exemption Regulation requires that the Authority's approval shall be sought by way of an application in writing:
 - (a) made to the Authority;
 - (b) in a manner and form specified by the Authority;
 - (c) by the appointee;
 - (d) accompanied by the prescribed fee;
 - (e) accompanied by a statutory declaration (see specimen in Annex A) as to the character and suitability of the trustee where section 5(1)(c) or (d) of Schedule 3 to the Exemption Regulation applies;
 - (f) accompanied by such additional particulars and undertakings as may be required by the Authority.
- 3. Section 6H of the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance (the Ordinance) provides that the Authority may issue guidelines for the guidance of approved trustees, service providers, participating employers and their

employees, self-employed persons, regulated persons and other persons concerned with the Ordinance.

4. The Authority hereby issues guidelines to specify the forms for application for appointment of trustees in respect of ORSO registered schemes which are exempted under section 16 of the Exemption Regulation and prescribe the information and documents to be submitted together with the application forms.

EFFECTIVE DATE

5. These revised Guidelines (Version 5 – April 2023) shall become effective on 24 April 2023. The previous version of these Guidelines (Version 4 – February 2016) shall be superseded on that day.

APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF RETIREMENT OR APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEE

Prescribed Forms

- 6. For new appointees which are companies, applications shall be made in the prescribed format as set out in Annex B (Form OI-TC). For new appointees who are natural persons, applications shall be made in the prescribed format as set out in Annex C (Form OI-TI).
- 7. For retirement of a trustee, there will not be any prescribed forms. An application in writing to the Authority specifying the name of the retiring trustee and the effective date of retirement signed by the person who has the power to retire the trustee will suffice.

8. The prescribed format of the forms in the Annexes can be downloaded from the Authority's website at: www.mpfa.org.hk.

Submission of Application

9. The completed application forms and the relevant application documents should be submitted in hard copies and sent, together with the application fees, to:

DEFINITION OF TERMS

10. Where a term used in the Guidelines is defined in the Ordinance or the subsidiary legislation then, except where specified in the Guidelines, that term carries the meaning as defined in the Ordinance or the subsidiary legislation.

WARNING

11. If there is any change to the application information or documents after an application is submitted to the Authority, the applicant should inform the Authority as soon as reasonably practicable. It is an offence under section 43E of the Ordinance if a person, in any document given to a prescribed person¹ in connection with the Ordinance, makes a statement that the person knows to be false or misleading in a material respect, or recklessly makes a statement which is false or misleading in a material respect.

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Prescribed person means (a) the Authority; (b) a system operator of an electronic MPF system; (c) an approved trustee; (d) a trustee of a relevant scheme; or (e) an auditor of an approved trustee or of a registered scheme.

NOTES ON PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION

 - (a) Section 20 of the Ordinance, Part 2 of the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes (General) Regulation (the General Regulation), and sections 42A, 42B, 42C and 42D of the General Regulation in relation to the application for approval as trustees and the application for approval as controllers of approved trustees;
 - (b) Section 21 of the Ordinance and Part 3 of the General Regulation in relation to the application for registration of schemes;
 - (c) Section 21BB of the Ordinance in relation to the approval of constituent funds;
 - (d) Section 6 of the General Regulation in relation to the approval of pooled investment funds;
 - (e) Section 7AB of the Ordinance in relation to submission of statements;
 - (f) Section 5 of the Ordinance, and sections 5, 14 and 16 of the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes (Exemption) Regulation (the Exemption Regulation) in relation to the application for exemption from MPF requirements;
 - (g) Section 7(3) of Schedule 3 to the Exemption Regulation in relation to the application for appointment of trustees/directors of trustees for MPF exempted ORSO registered schemes;
 - (h) Section 8 of the Exemption Regulation in relation to the application for withdrawal of exemption certificates of ORSO exempted schemes; and
 - (i) Section 19 of the Exemption Regulation in relation to the application for withdrawal of exemption certificates of ORSO registered schemes.

Provision of such personal data is necessary for the exercise or performance of the functions of the Authority conferred or imposed by or under the Ordinance (including the regulations and rules made thereunder). Failure to supply the requested personal data may result in delay or refusal of the application if it affects the Authority's ability to assess the applicant's compliance with the applicable criteria.

- 2. The personal data supplied by you shall be used by the Authority for the purposes of exercising or performing its functions conferred or imposed by or under the Ordinance (including the regulations and rules made thereunder), including whatever surveillance, investigation, inspection or enforcement action necessary to the discharge of such functions.
- 3. In the course of exercising or performing its functions, the Authority may, as permitted by law, match, compare, transfer or exchange the data provided by you with data held, or hereafter obtained, for these or any other purposes by the Authority, government bodies, other regulatory authorities, corporations, organizations or individuals in Hong Kong or overseas for the purposes of the Ordinance.
- 4. Specified data relating to approved trustees, registered schemes and MPF exempted ORSO registered/exempted schemes are kept open for public inspection pursuant to sections 20C, 21B and 5A of the Ordinance respectively.
